



Application for an Off-Target Well

1. A submission under section 27 of *The Oil and Gas Conservation Act* in support of an application for an off-target well, for geological or reservoir reasons (development drilling in a drainage unit not previously drilled) shall contain, where possible:
 - (a) The location and co-ordinates of the proposed off-target well.
 - (b) A general discussion of the geology in the vicinity of the proposed well clearly showing that a well in the on-target location would result in a dry hole or an uneconomic well. This shall include, if possible:
 - (i) a geological cross-section of the pool showing the proposed location;
 - (ii) an isopach map of the net pay in the target horizon;
 - (iii) a contour map of the top of the target horizon;
 - (iv) a map showing the lessors (mineral owners) and lessees within and adjoining the project area;
 - (v) any additional geological, geophysical or other data which supports the application (ie, seismic structure maps, etc.).
 - (c) A discussion of the zones which are being produced in the vicinity of the proposed well including the reservoir characteristics of the zones (ie: porosity, permeability, etc.).
 - (d) An estimate of the anticipated production rates from the proposed off-target well.
 2. The applicant may indicate that he is requesting a waiver of the off-target penalty.
 3. The submission shall be in written and illustrated form, signed by an officer of the company making the application, and appropriately bound.
 4. The applicant shall, upon request, provide additional copies of the submission to any owners or operators directly affected.
