## Non-Lawyer Witness Certificate

### ***Purpose***

The *Non-Lawyer Witness Certificate* form (CF13.2) is used when a member of the association chooses to use two non-lawyer adults as witness to an *Enduring Power of Attorney* form (CF13).

### ***Completion***

- 1) The form must include:
  - names and addresses of the two witnesses;
  - name of the grantor; **and**
  - dated signatures of the two non-lawyer witnesses.
  
- 2) When the *Enduring Power of Attorney* form is witnessed in the presence of two non-lawyer adults, the original *Non-Lawyer Witness Certificate* form (CF13.2) must be kept on file by the association with a copy sent to the provincial supervisor and the lender.
