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Loan Extension Application (Breeder)

Purpose

The *Loan Extension Application (Breeder)* (form CF24) is a request by a member to extend the repayment date on a breeder loan(s) taken by the association on the member's behalf.

Policies

• The Loan Extension Application (Breeder) is made to the board of directors of the association and is limited to a maximum of six months beyond the original due date of the loan.

Completion and Approval

- 1) The member must complete the top portion of the application, including:
 - the name of the association;
 - the member's name and nearest city/town;
 - the date the loan was advanced;
 - the date the payment is currently due;
 - the date to which they would like the loan to be extended;
 - a full explanation of why the extension is being requested and the date the repayment will likely be made: and
 - the member's signature and the date.
- 2) The local supervisor must complete a physical inspection to confirm the number and condition of the member's entire breeder cattle inventory and must report the results of this inspection on the application, prior to signing and dating the application.
- 3) The board of directors should use the *Board of Director's Application Review Checklist* (form CF12) when reviewing the application. If approved, a board member with signing authority and another association signing officer sign and date the application prior to forwarding it to the lender for approval.
- 4) The lender reviews the application and, if approved, signs and dates the application and forwards it to the provincial supervisor.
- 5) The provincial supervisor reviews the application and, if approved, signs and dates the application and returns the original to the association with a copy sent to the lender. The lender is then in a position to extend the loan for the approved length of time.
