Check-Off Exemption

Purpose

The *Check-Off Exemption* form (CF29) is used when the association transfers cattle between options, without a change of ownership occurring, and wants to exempt the transaction from check-off fees.

Policy

Completion of the *Check-Off Exemption* allows for the transaction described on the form to be exempt from the cattle check-off fee.

Completion

The *Check-Off Exemption* form must include the:

- name of the association;
- number and type of cattle transferred;
- the name of the member on whose behalf the transfer was made;
- the signature of the secretary-treasurer or local supervisor; **and**
- the date.
