Saskatchewan Alcohol Use Polling Results, October 2006

Highlights

- 1,200 people (including 199 ages 18-29) in the general population were surveyed between September 26 and October 12, 2006.
- 499 youth between the ages of 18-29 were surveyed between September 26 and October 22, 2006. Margin of Error +/-4.4% from total age group population of 170,000.
- Total cost of the survey is \$25,715.61.
- 29.6% of the youth surveyed have drunk 5 or more drinks (classically described by the Canadian Medical Association as "binge drinking") more frequently than monthly, compared with 14.6% of the general population. 10.9% of the youth surveyed describe drinking 5 or 6 drinks as "drinking in moderation", compared with 4.1% of the general population.
- 40.5% of the youth surveyed have had more than 10 drinks on at least one occasion in the past 12 months (compared with 15.5% of the general population).
- Most youth (69.2%) drink with friends.
- The top three reasons for drinking are "to be sociable", "to relax", and for "recreation".
- 25% of youth began drinking before reaching the age of 15 and they are starting to drink sooner than previous generations.
- 58.3% of youth say they drank more than they had intended to at least once in the past 12 months; youth are twice as likely as the general population to drink more than they had intended to at least monthly.
- 19.2% of young respondents say they have failed to do what was expected of them at least once in the past year due to drinking.
- At least once during the past year due to drinking 7.1% of young respondents say that they failed to go to work; 7.4% failed to go to school and 27.0% have experienced feelings of guilt or remorse after drinking.
- 27.4% of young respondents say that at least once during the past year, they have been unable to remember events of the past night due to drinking.
- 21.2% of young respondents have been in arguments at least once during the past year with friends or family because of their drinking.
- 14.6% of young respondents say that their drinking resulted in someone being physically injured at least once in the past year.
- When asked to name the greatest risk about drinking to excess, 51.6% of young respondents cite drinking and driving.
