Particulars of Position:

Position will function as an aerial observer, with duties to include detection of fires, plotting location, documenting smoke reports and patrol reports, relaying relevant information to fire bases or initial attack crews and conducting debriefings with supervisor. Position will be required to operate a VHF/FM radio and obtain a restricted radio operator's license, operate a digital camera and develop reports utilizing a computer. Applicant must be able to travel in small aircraft for up to 4 hours at a time during extreme fire conditions and be able to work away from home base. Other duties as assigned.

Candidates must clearly indicate in their covering letter or resume where they have acquired their knowledge and abilities. Selections for interviews will be made on the basis of this information.

To Qualify:

- Possess and maintain a Saskatchewan Class 5 driver's license
- Good vision with or without vision enhancement i.e. glasses, contact lenses
- Pass ParQ health questionnaire and physically able to perform job duties

You will have knowledge of:

- Ability to read maps
- Ability to operate a two way radio
- Basic mathematical calculations to record and relay map coordinates
