Particulars of Position:

Reporting to the Chief Pilot, you will be responsible for providing pilot services, flying primarily as a Captain on CV 580A aircraft in forest fire suppression and/or personal transport activities throughout the province and country as required. Additional skills and experience in a northern environment i.e. remote work settings, flight experience in Saskatchewan (the forested sector in particular), and fire fighting experience will be considered an asset. Candidates with extensive CV 580 experience and depth of knowledge attained through such experience will be given preference in the selection.

Candidates must clearly indicate in their covering letter or résumé where they have acquired their knowledge, skills and abilities. Selections of candidates to be interviewed will be made on the basis of this information.

To qualify you must possess:

- Valid airline transport license;
- 4000 hours pilot in command;
- Minimum of four years aerial forest fire suppression experience;
- The ability to pass an Annual Transport Canada Instrument Flight test and company Pilot Proficiency Check as required by NAO and MOT;
- Two years or 500 hours First Officer on CV 580 or CL 215;
- Two years or 500 hours as Bird Dog Pilot;
- Float endorsement and a minimum 500 hours PIC on Floats or Amphibious aircraft;
- or a minimum of two years or 500 hours as Captain on CL 215, Tracker or CV 580 with PPC on type.

You will have knowledge of:

- The CV 580 flying characteristics, general maintenance needs, ways of assisting with trouble shooting and isolating maintenance problems, various understanding that experience brings and how this applies to fire suppression operations, and general extensive knowledge of the aircraft type
- Aircraft surface contamination to successfully complete annual exam
- Cockpit resource management
- Wild land fire suppression methods and strategies, fire weather, fuel types and how they affect fire behavior
- Wilderness survival and first aid

You will have the ability to:

- Independently identify work requirements and safety margins
- Communicate effectively in person and over the radio with a diverse work force
- Work and live with your fellow employees in remote settings for prolonged periods of time and maintain good group relations
- Work in a multi-cultural environment
