Saskatchewan Environment and Resource Management is seeking an innovative individual for an Electronics Technician position to work in a well-equipped facility located in Prince Albert. The duties involve the diagnosis, repair, modification, installation and design of a wide variety of electronic equipment in shop and field settings as well as the design and delivery of staff training seminars. The majority of the work is focused on the maintenance of a wireless communications fleet with over three thousand units. Other equipment includes data collection platforms, microprocessors, and enforcement and surveillance equipment. You will be expected to work in inclement weather and to travel on northern roads and in a variety of ATV's as well as fixed and rotary wing aircraft. The successful candidate may be required to live in camp conditions during fire season. Heavy lifting is occasionally necessary. May be required to climb a tower to perform repairs.
