Responsible to manage equipment, fuel and facility management activities within the fire management area to include: maintain, track and reconcile inventory of fire equipment, communications equipment and fuel supplies; inspect incoming equipment shipments for serviceability and completeness. Complete inventory forms, equipment transfers and write-offs, forward results to Provincial Fire Center Depot as required. Perform maintenance on minor equipment and facilities or grounds. Order equipment, parts and supplies and pick-up or delivery as required. Conduct maintenance checks at fire cache and re-stock equipment. Other duties as assigned.

Candidates must clearly indicate in their covering letter or resume where they have acquired their knowledge and abilities. Selections for interviews will be made on the basis of this information.
