Will be familiar with the park flora, fauna and other ecosystem components. Disseminate information and respond to questions relating to the natural environment of the park. Responsibilities also include the general upkeep, safety and cleanliness of interpretive facilities. Trail upkeep and/or trail design. Also includes occasional programming of recreational events. The expected start date is May 1, 2003.

An interest in the outdoors and related hobbies is an asset. This position requires knowledge and experience in interpretive theory, program design and delivery. The ability to clearly and tactfully communicate information, to the general public and school-aged children, is required. Previous experience working with children and with events programming would be an asset. Must possess a valid driver's license. Preference will be given to applicants with valid First Aid and CPR certificates.
