Particulars of Position:

This position will have shared responsibility with Fire Technicians for supervising, assessing work performance, and providing leadership and direction to Initial Attack Crew Members, EFF's First Nations and Northern Works Personnel. This position is responsible for wild land fire suppression, forest protection, public education, wild land fire prevention, and the delivery of wild land training programs (EFF, general public, FSIN, volunteer fire departments). As well as other assigned duties that may include: work related to site development and maintenance, firewood projects and other Department work programs, etc. Typical duties include ordering of air tanker support, ordering and maintaining food, equipment and commissary, completing all related forms and reports, crew scheduling, burning permit inspections, operate and maintain a fire cache. Good radio communications skills and accurate documentation of occurrences would be considered an asset. Must possess a valid Class 5 Saskatchewan driver's license.

Candidates must clearly indicate in their covering letter or resume' where they have acquired their knowledge and abilities. Selections for interviews will be made on the basis of this information.
