You will be responsible to detect smoke from fires and plot locations on maps. Communicate locations of fires to Fire Bases. You will be required to operate a VHF radio and light equipment. You will be required to take a basic Observer's training course. You will also need to carry out buildings and ground maintenance i.e. painting, grass cutting, etc. as well as other duties as assigned. Applicants with knowledge of the local area would be considered an asset.
