You will be required to take a basic Observer's training course. You will also need to carry out buildings and ground maintenance i.e. painting, grass cutting, etc. as well as other duties as assigned. Applicants with knowledge of the local area would be considered an asset.

Candidates must clearly indicate in their covering letter or resume' where they have acquired their knowledge and abilities. Selections for interviews will be made on the basis of this information.
