Particulars of Position:

Perform park maintenance duties (i.e. collection of litter and garbage, removal of ash from barbecues, distributing firewood, raking sites, mowing, trimming, rototilling). Perform janitorial and sanitation functions in buildings (i.e. washing, disinfecting and sanitizing with proper chemicals). Perform maintenance and minor repairs to facilities (i.e. painting/staining, etc). Prepare and maintain flowerbeds, shrubs and plantations in the park. Interact with park visitors, supply general information and deliver emergency messages. Operate light equipment such as mowers, light trucks, weed trimmers and small hand tools. Must be available to work weekends.

Candidates must clearly indicate in their covering letter or résumé where they have acquired their knowledge, skills and abilities. Selections of candidates to be interviewed will be made on the basis of this information.
