Particulars of Position

Provide radio communication to Department staff and air support while involved in the fire suppression activities. Transmits and receives messages to and from personal in the field. Provide a flight watch for all aircraft working out of that fire base. Maintain a detailed written record of all radio and telephone communications (e.g. Location of aircraft, personal, requests for equipment, locations of fires, etc.) Broadcast daily alerts and weather indices to the area fire towers. You will be required to take a "Radio Telephone Operator's restricted Certificate Course". The work requires the candidate to operate and care for radio and telecommunications equipment. You will be required to work shift work and weekends. Candidates who possess a radio operator's certificate would be considered an asset in the selection process.

Candidates must clearly indicate in their covering letter or résumé where they have acquired their knowledge, skills and abilities. Selections of candidates to be interviewed will be made on the basis of this information.

Knowledge of: proper radio procedures; working knowledge of types of fixed wing and rotary wing aircraft used in fire suppression; working knowledge of fire fighting tools, techniques and terminology; general office practices and procedures relating to the handling of record keeping and telephone etiquette; computer applications including work processing software; latitude and longitude location identification for plotting purposes. Demonstrated ability to: provide written documents in a clear, neat and accurate format; be strong, clear and confident communicator; contribute to team effectiveness and morale; able to work for long periods of intense activity; work in a multi-cultural environment.
