Position will function as a Fire Tower Observer, with duties to include detection of fires, plotting location, and documenting smoke, relaying information to fire base or initial attack crews. You will be required to operate a VHF radio and light equipment. You will also carry out building and ground maintenance (i.e. painting, grass cutting, and other duties as assigned). To qualify you must have a valid class 5 Saskatchewan Drivers License. You must pass a PAR Q health questionnaire and be physically able to perform job duties.
