## Free Saskatchewan Provincial Park Entry

- Saskatchewan seniors will receive a free park entry permit when they enter a provincial park upon providing identification verifying their age and residency.
- Seniors will be required to pay other park fees, such as camping fees and swimming pool fees.
- All people travelling in a passenger vehicle with a senior will also receive free entry to provincial parks.
- Free provincial park entry for seniors is available now.
- Seniors from out of province will be required to pay regular park entry fees.



## Free Saskatchewan Angling Licences

- Seniors who produce proof of age and Saskatchewan residency are able to obtain a free angling licence from any of the over 1,000 hunting and angling licence vendors across the province.
- Seniors will still need to meet all other fishing regulations, such as possessing an angling licence, honouring catch limits and fishing seasons.
- Seniors from out of province will be required to buy angling licences.
- Effective immediately, seniors who paid for an angling licence can get a refund by taking their angling licence to any Saskatchewan Environment office or provincial park office. Retail vendors cannot provide a refund.
