# RE: THE INSURANCE PREMIUMS TAX ACT

The March 29, 2000 Budget increased Insurance Premiums Tax rates effective April 1, 2000.

The Insurance Premiums Tax rate for life, accident and sickness insurance was increased from 2% to 3%. The Insurance Premiums Tax rate for all other insurance, except hail insurance, was increased from 3% to 4%. The tax on hail insurance was not increased and remains at 3%.

The Insurance Premiums Tax rate for <u>individual</u> life, accident and sickness insurance policies in force <u>before</u> April 1, 2000 will be taxed at 2% until such time as the individual policy no longer exists. Individual life, accident and sickness insurance policies written <u>after</u> March 31, 2000 will be taxed at the new rate of 3%. This change applies to individual policies only. It does not affect group policies.

A revised Premium Tax return is enclosed. Lines "A2a" and "B2a" of the return allow for a 1% credit to be claimed for individual life, accident and sickness insurance policies in force which were written prior to April 1, 2000.
