

Annex III Schedule of Canada

Canada takes an exception to the Most-Favoured-Nation Treatment Article under the Investment Chapter for treatment accorded under all bilateral or multilateral international agreements in force or signed prior to the date of entry into force of this Agreement.

For international agreements in force or signed after the date of entry into force of this Agreement, Canada takes an exception to the Most-Favoured-Nation Treatment Article under the Investment Chapter for treatment accorded under those agreements involving:

- (a) aviation;
- (b) fisheries;
- (c) maritime matters, including salvage; or
- (d) telecommunications transport networks and telecommunications transport services.

For greater certainty, the Most-Favoured-Nation Treatment Article under the Investment Chapter does not apply to any current or future foreign aid programme to promote economic development, such as those governed by the Energy Economic Cooperation Program with Central America and the Caribbean (Pacto de San José) and the OECD Agreement on Export Credits.
