NOTICE OF NOMINATION AND ELECTION PROCEDURE

A. Nominations for Election of British Columbia Members to Council

Under the By-Laws of the British Columbia Branch of the Canadian Bar Association, each County in the Province shall be represented on Council. This year there are **nine (9)** members to be elected for **three (3)** year terms. **Only CBA members are eligible for nomination and election and if elected, must maintain CBA membership throughout their term of office.**

Those eligible to ***nominate*** and ***vote*** for a county representative are **CBA members** who are:

- a) *Practising* members whose principal place of *business* is in the County, and
- b) *Non-practising* members whose *residence* is situated in the County.
