Canadian Environmental Assessment Act Comprehensive Study Continental Stone Limited Crushed Granite Rock Quarry

Consultation on the Proposed Scope of the Project and the Availability of Participant Funding

Continental Stone Limited proposes to develop a rock quarry north of Belleoram on the south coast of Newfoundland and Labrador. Granite will be quarried and crushed on site using standard industry methodologies and loaded onto marine bulk carriers via a conveyor belt and shipped to market. Development will include: wharf construction; road construction; removal of overburden; building construction; equipment set-up; drilling; blasting; and crushing of rock for transport by bulk carrier.

The project is subject to a comprehensive study under the *Canadian Environmental Assessment Act*. Transport Canada, Fisheries and Oceans Canada, and the Atlantic Canada Opportunities Agency, as the federal responsible authorities for the project assessment, now invite the public to comment on the proposed scope of project, the factors to be considered, the proposed scope of the factors, and the ability of the comprehensive study to address issues relating to the project.
