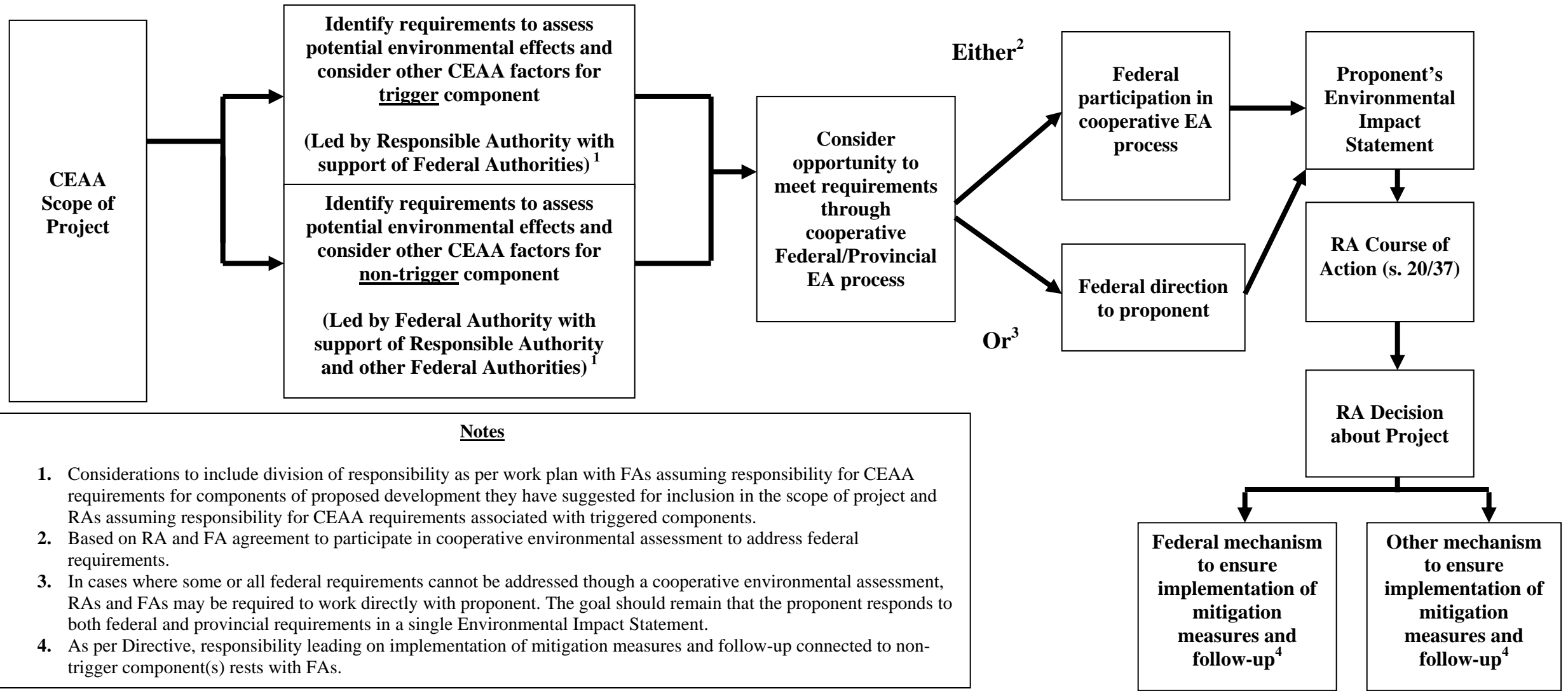


**Process for Reaching and Applying Scope of Project Determinations under the
Canadian Environmental Assessment Act for Major Projects with Regulatory Triggers**

CEAA Scope of Assessment



Notes

1. Considerations to include division of responsibility as per work plan with FAs assuming responsibility for CEAA requirements for components of proposed development they have suggested for inclusion in the scope of project and RAs assuming responsibility for CEAA requirements associated with triggered components.
2. Based on RA and FA agreement to participate in cooperative environmental assessment to address federal requirements.
3. In cases where some or all federal requirements cannot be addressed through a cooperative environmental assessment, RAs and FAs may be required to work directly with proponent. The goal should remain that the proponent responds to both federal and provincial requirements in a single Environmental Impact Statement.
4. As per Directive, responsibility leading on implementation of mitigation measures and follow-up connected to non-trigger component(s) rests with FAs.
