## CANADA – NOVA SCOTIA OFFSHORE PETROLEUM BOARD

## **BEPCO EXPLORATORY DRILLING PROGRAM**

The Canada – Nova Scotia Offshore Petroleum Board (the Board) has received a project description from BEPCo Canada to conduct an exploratory drilling program on its Exploration Licence 2407. These wells are proposed to be drilled outside a previously assessed area and will be reviewed through the Comprehensive Study process under the *Canadian Environmental Assessment Act*.

The first step of this process is the issuance of a Scoping Document which provides guidance to what must be included in the Environmental Assessment. The Board has released a copy of the Scoping Document for written public comments. The deadline for submissions is **noon on June 18<sup>th</sup>**, **2004**.
