Program Details

The Newfoundland and Labrador Home Heating Rebate provides assistance of up to \$200 for households which incur heating costs, regardless of their primary source of heat. A partial rebate is available to households with family net income for 2005 above \$22,500 but less than \$30,000, with a minimum rebate of \$100. Only one person per household may apply for the rebate. Applications should be submitted to the Provincial Department of Finance and must be received or postmarked by April 30, 2007. An application cannot be processed without the appropriate Social Insurance Number(s). Enquiries may be made locally within the St. John's area at 729-1695, or toll-free long distance at 1-877-729-1695. Please allow 6 to 8 weeks for processing of applications.

Special Circumstances

Changes made to this year's rebate mean that you may still qualify even if your family net income for 2005 exceeds \$30,000. If any of the following circumstances apply to you, **please check the appropriate box**. You will be required to provide documentation as indicated to support your claim.

Death of a Spouse - If your spouse was deceased as of December 31, 2006 and reported income in 2005, your eligibility will be based on your income only. Please provide your spouse's social insurance number and a copy of the death certificate.

Long-Term Care - If your spouse is a resident of a long-term care facility, you are able to deduct payments to the facility supporting his or her care in determining your eligibility. Please provide documentation supporting the amount and nature of payments.

Funded Adult Basic Education (ABE)/Skills Development - If you received government funding in 2005 to attend an ABE program or for skills development and that funding was included on your 2005 income tax return, you may deduct this funding in determining your eligibility. Please provide documents supporting the government assistance as well as your enrollment in the course.
