Minimum Writ Period: (28 days) The minimum number of days between issue of the Writ of Election and Nomination Day is 11 clear days. (The date fixed for issuing the Writ of Election and the date fixed for Nomination Day are to be excluded (clause 31(3)(b) and subsection (4)).

Maximum Writ Period: (34 days) The maximum number of days between issue of the Writ of Election and Nomination Day is 17 clear days. (The date fixed for issuing the Writ of Election and the date fixed for Nomination Day are to be excluded (clause 31(3)(b) and subsection (4)).

Within three months after Election Day (Friday, February 8, 2008) the audited Candidate's Return of Election Expenses, Form E-412, is to be filed with the constituency Returning Officer for subsequent forwarding to the Chief Electoral Officer (261(1)).

Within six months after Election Day (Thursday, May 8, 2008), the audited Registered Political Party's Return of Election Expenses, Form E-524, is to be filed with the Chief Electoral Officer (251(1)).

Within 30 days of receipt of any return respecting election expenses, the Returning Officer must publish a summary thereof, in the prescribed form, in one newspaper published or circulated in the constituency in which the election was held (261(8)).
