WHEREAS the Canada Industrial Relations Board has received an application from the applicants, pursuant to section 38(1) of the *Canada Labour Code (Part I - Industrial Relations)*, seeking revocation of certification order no. 8608-U issued on February 24, 2004, certifying the Grain Services Union (ILWU - Canada) as bargaining agent for a unit of employees of 101043907 Saskatchewan Ltd. comprising:

"all employees of 101043907 Saskatchewan Ltd. working at or in connection with its feed mill at Bruno, Saskatchewan, <u>excluding</u> the general manager and controller."

AND WHEREAS, following investigation of the application, consideration of the submissions of the parties concerned and the taking of a representation vote, the Board is satisfied that a majority of the employees in the bargaining unit no longer wish to be represented by the Grain Services Union (ILWU - Canada).
