**WHEREAS** the Canada Industrial Relations Board has received an application for certification from the applicant union as bargaining agent for a unit of employees of 2389070 Canada inc., doing business as Top Gun Courrier, pursuant to section 24.1 of the *Canada Labour Code (Part I - Industrial Relations)*;

**AND WHEREAS** there exists a collective agreement between the parties, the terms of which are not expired;

**AND WHEREAS**, following investigation of the application and consideration of the submissions of the parties concerned, the Board has found the applicant to be a trade union within the meaning of the *Code* and has determined the unit described hereunder to be appropriate for collective bargaining and is satisfied that a majority of the employees of the employer in the unit wish to have the applicant trade union represent them as their bargaining agent.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, it is ordered by the Canada Industrial Relations Board that Cartage and Miscellaneous Employees' Union, Local 931 be, and it is hereby certified to be, the bargaining agent for a unit comprising:

"all subcontractor courriers working for 2389070 Canada Inc. doing business as Top Gun Courrier <u>excluding</u> dispatchers and secretaries."
