WHEREAS the Canada Industrial Relations Board has received an application for certification from the applicant union as bargaining agent for a unit of employees of 3506363 Canada Inc. (Kyd Messengers Services), pursuant to section 24.1 of the *Canada Labour Code* (*Part I - Industrial Relations*);

AND WHEREAS, following investigation of the application and consideration of the submissions of the parties concerned, the Board has found the applicant to be a trade union within the meaning of the *Code* and has determined the unit described hereunder to be appropriate for collective bargaining and is satisfied that a majority of the employees of the employer in the unit wish to have the applicant trade union represent them as their bargaining agent.

AND WHEREAS the parties are bound by a collective agreement entered into on March 15, 2006 and which expires on April 8, 2009;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is ordered by the Canada Industrial Relations Board that the Canadian Union of Postal Workers be, and it is hereby certified to be, the bargaining agent for a unit comprising:

"all messengers who are commissioned delivery persons, owners or lessees of their vehicle or their bicycle, delivery drivers utilizing the company's vehicle or walkers or all other salaried persons carrying -2-

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out duties related to the pick-up, transport and delivery of letters and small parcels, <u>excluding</u> management, administrative and dispatching personnel."
