

Canadian Textiles Institute and First Responders Conference/Trade Show

Tuesday, November 28, 2006 Fairmont Queen Elizabeth Hotel Montréal (Québec)

What?

- The premiere edition of the CTI-First Responders Conference/Trade Show, organized by the Canadian Textiles Institute (CTI) with the cooperation of the Canadian Police Research Centre (CPRC).
- A targeted one-day event focusing on the textile/personal protective equipment needs of first responders.
- A Conference featuring presentations from both first responders (identifying needs and challenges related to personal protective equipment) and manufacturers (highlighting the latest developments in textiles and personal protective equipment).
- A Trade Show, involving exhibitors from the first responders community and textile and personal equipment firms, showcasing textile and related products currently in use and in development.
- An opportunity to exchange ideas, information and views, and to make key contacts.

Who should participate?

First Responders, including fire services, police services, emergency medical professionals (EMTs, paramedics), and security firms. In particular, police chiefs, fire chiefs, procurement specialists, technical personnel involved in specifying equipment requirements, etc.

Municipal, provincial and federal government officials responsible for the development of technical specifications for textiles and personal equipment for first responders and involved in the procurement process.

Textile and personal protective equipment manufacturers producing products and gear for the first responders community.

Why?

To facilitate dialogue and collaboration between first responders and Canadian textile and personal equipment manufacturers to insure the safety, comfort and well-being of first responders.

....bringing together first responders and Canadian manufacturers to identify and address needs, challenges, capabilities and opportunities related to textiles and personal protective equipment.

VENUE

The premiere edition of the CTI-First Responders Conference/Trade Show will be held in the centre of downtown Montréal at the Fairmont Queen Elizabeth Hotel. For participants located outside of Montréal, this location can be easily accessed by train and has ample parking.

A block of bedrooms (limited availability) has been reserved at the Queen Elizabeth Hotel at the special rate of \$189.00/night for Conference/Trade Show participants. Participants are responsible for their own reservations. A hotel reservation form with all the required information will be sent to Conference delegates once they have registered.

TRADE SHOW RULES AND CONDITIONS

The Trade Show will feature exhibitors from both the first responders community and textile and personal equipment manufacturing firms. Space is limited, so early booking is advised.

Exhibitors must complete the Exhibit Booth Application Form and return it to CTI with payment. Full payment is required to secure the booth space requested. CTI reserves the right to change assigned spaces if required. The deadline for Exhibit Booth Applications and payment is October 20, 2006. No refunds will be issued for cancellations after October 20, 2006.

Only registered Conference delegates will have access to the Trade Show area. Conference delegates can register by completing the Conference Registration Form. Booth contact persons and persons manning the booths attending the Trade Show must also be registered as Conference delegates.

Solicitation at the Trade Show by non-exhibitors is strictly prohibited.

<u>Dismantling of exhibits prior to the Trade Show closing is not permitted.</u>

The Trade Show will be closed during the Conference presentations to provide all exhibitors with an opportunity to hear the speakers and for security.

CONFERENCE DELEGATES RULES AND CONDITIONS

Only registered Conference delegates will have access to the CTI-First Responders Conference/Trade Show activities (including the Trade Show, the Conference presentations, the lunch and the cocktail). All Conference delegates must complete a Conference Registration Form. Persons who have not registered will not have access to the activities.

Completed Conference Registration Forms and full payment must be received by CTI by November 17, 2006. Full payment is required to confirm registration. No refunds will be issued for cancellations after November 17, 2006. (Note: There are different rates for Registrations received before and after October 30, 2006).
