Created in May 2000, the Atlantic Canada Film Partners is comprised of Atlantic Canada's four film development corporations - Technology PEI, Nova Scotia Film Development Corporation, New Brunswick Film, Newfoundland and Labrador Film Development Corporation - the Atlantic Canada Opportunities Agency (ACOA) and Telefilm Canada.

The partnership was formed to ensure that regional film and television producers have access to: international marketplaces to promote their work, strategic professional development, business planning services, and industrial research.

The objective of the Atlantic Canada Film Partners is to increase the general production of film and television in the region, thereby generating more jobs in the film industry, encouraging foreign investment, and increasing the feasibility of productions in this region
