Re: Sponsorship of Phoenix InfoNews Channel

- Rogers Cable Communications Inc. (Rogers), in our capacity as a Canadian sponsor, requests Phoenix InfoNews Channel (Phoenix InfoNews) be added to the Lists of Eligible Satellite Services for distribution on a digital basis (the digital lists).
- 2. On December 16, 2004, the Commission announced a new approach to assessing requests for non-Canadian third-language television services to be added to the digital lists¹. Rogers notes that requests for foreign third-language services that provide narrowly targeted or niche programming will be assessed on a case-by-case assessment to determine whether the service is partially or totally competitive with Canadian services. There is currently no Canadian licensed service that offers programming in the same language and format of Phoenix InfoNews. To assist the Commission in its assessment, and as required in BPN 2004-96, the information respecting Phoenix InfoNews is provided in the attachment.
- 3. Phoenix InfoNews is a 24-hour niche news service based in Hong Kong providing a comprehensive menu of news and information on world events, current affairs and financial developments in Mandarin. It offers a programming from the following categories: news, analysis and Interpretation, long-form documentary,

reporting and actualities, information education/recreation and leisure and sports. Approximately 85% of the service's programming schedule consists of programming that is within the news, analysis and interpretation genres.

- 4. Launched in January 2001, Phoenix InfoNews was the first 24 hours satellite news channel in Mandarin serving audiences in the Asia Pacific. It is currently uplinked to the Galaxy 3C satellite covering North America and is also available in the U.S. on DIRECTV and EchoStar. Phoenix InfoNews is owned and operated by a wholly-owned subsidiary of Phoenix Satellite Television Holdings Limited, which is listed on the GEM board of The Stock Exchange of Hong Kong Limited and is an associate of The News Corporation Limited and Today's Asia Limited.
- 5. Rogers is Canada's largest cable television distributor. Our 150 cable systems located in Ontario, New Brunswick and Newfoundland pass 3.4 million homes and serve approximately 2.3 million customers. This represents more than a third of all cable subscribers in Canada, and more than a fifth of the total number of Canadian homes that currently receive television services from a licensed broadcast distribution undertaking (BDU) in Canada. Rogers' systems are clustered in major markets which include the Greater Toronto Area (GTA), Ottawa, London and the Kitchener/Guelph corridor. We are Canada's leading distributor of third-language programming services.
- 6. The fact that Rogers is requesting that Phoenix InfoNews be added to the digital lists demonstrates the potential demand for this service in Canada. Rogers believes that legitimizing carriage of non-Canadian services will not only respond to consumer demand for greater choice but it will provide our customers with an incentive to remain a vital part of the Canadian broadcasting system and help increase the benefits associated with digital cable television.
- 7. Rogers believes that international services clearly make a unique and significant contribution to the diversity of the Canadian broadcasting system. In a global environment, it is increasingly important that Canadians have access to multiple sources of programming services. In conclusion, Rogers believes that carriage of Phoenix InfoNews will not only expand the diversity and choice in television services available to underserved third-language ethnic communities in Canada, but it will contribute to the growth of digital cable television to the benefit of both our subscribers and Canadian programming services.

Re: Sponsorship application for the Phoenix InfoNews Channel

This letter serves as evidence that the Phoenix InfoNews Channel ("Phoenix InfoNews") has agreed to be sponsored by the Rogers Cable Communications Inc. (Rogers) for inclusion on the digital lists of Eligible Satellite Services ("the Lists"). We understand that, should our service be added to the Lists, the service would be available to all distribution undertakings in Canada.

Description of Service

Phoenix InfoNews is a niche news service providing a comprehensive menu of news and information on world events, current affairs and financial developments in Mandarin 24 hours a day, seven days a week.

Established in 2001, Phoenix InfoNews is widely regarded as the premier Mandarin Chinese news service. Besides interviewing key world leaders, including President Bush and Prime Minister Blair, Phoenix InfoNews provides a comprehensive menu of news and information on world events, current affairs and financial developments 24 hours a day, seven days a week. Its first hand live coverage of major international events, such as the violence in Iraq, the ongoing tension in Israel-Palestinian relations, and the terrorist attacks on London, matches the coverage the major international news services.

Phoenix InfoNews also covers regional issues, such as the visit to mainland China of key Taiwan political figures, last December's elections in Taiwan, the humiliation of female

Chinese visitors to Malaysia, and the evolution of Japanese policy towards China, Taiwan and East Asia more broadly, that are of direct interest to the global Chinese audience but which are rarely covered by any other international television news services. No other Mandarin language broadcaster combines international and regional, China-related news as comprehensively as Phoenix InfoNews does.

Programming

Attached please find a detailed breakdown of programming by genre, expressed as both the total number of hours per week, and as a percentage of the overall weekly programming schedule.

Attached is a program schedule for the first quarter of 2006. In order to allow ready comparisons with the Commission's program categories, the staff at Phoenix Infonews has broken down the programming for the week of February 6-February 12, 2006 in that manner and the result is shown below:

Other than Category 1 News and Category 2(a) Analysis and Interpretation, the total of all other genres is 15.7% and no one other genre exceeds 5% of the program schedule.

There are no English subtitles and no SAP. All programming is in Mandarin..

Demand for Service

The fact that Rogers, as the largest broadcasting distributor in Canada, has requested that Phoenix InfoNews be added to the digital lists demonstrates the potential demand for our service in Canada. Rogers added the Phoenix North America Chinese Channel at the end of November, 2005 and already the power and prestige of the Phoenix brand and the high quality of the programming is attracting Canadians. And the Phoenix InfoNews service has already proven its value in other major markets such as the United States (where it is carried on both EchoStar and DirecTV) and in mainland China, where it was admitted in 2003. The popularity of the service in other markets supplies additional ample proof of the popularity of the Phoenix InfoNews service.

Rights for Distribution of Programming in Canada

Phoenix InfoNews confirms that it has obtained all necessary rights for distribution of its programming in Canada.

Non-Preferential or Non-Exclusive Programming Rights

Phoenix InfoNews confirms that it does not hold, and will not obtain, nor will it exercise preferential or exclusive programming rights in relation to the distribution of programming in Canada.

Programming Supply Agreement

Phoenix InfoNews does not have, nor has is it ever had, a program supply agreement with a Canadian service.

Competitiveness with Canadian licensed services

There is currently no Canadian licensed service in the Mandarin language in the format of Phoenix InfoNews. Phoenix InfoNews notes that the Commission previously approved an application by Fairchild Media Group (OBCI) in Decision CRTC 2000-709 for a national Category 2 specialty service to be known as the Fairchild News Channel to provide a service consisting of news, information, public affairs and financial planning. The Commission's approval has now lapsed and the service never launched.

Conclusion

We appreciate Rogers' support for Phoenix InfoNews. We believe that Phoenix InfoNews can add substantially to the diversity of programming being offered by Canadian cable operators as part of their digital cable service.
