ORDER NO. 91-11

Pursuant to Section 4 of the Dairy Products Act, the Farm Products Marketing Commission orders as follows:

1. This Order shall be entitled "Size of Containers Order".
2. Definitions:
"Milk and Cream" means Milk and Cream as defined in the Dairy Products Act.
"Milk Dealer" means Milk Dealer as defined in the Dairy Products Act.
"Storekeeper" means Storekeeper as defined in the Dairy Products Act.
3. No Milk Dealer or Storekeeper shall sell milk and cream in New Brunswick in a container of a size other than the following sizes:
 - (a) 15 millilitres
 - (b) 200 millilitres
 - (c) 250 millilitres
 - (d) 500 millilitres
 - (e) 501 millilitres only for chocolate milk and chocolate partly skim
 - (f) one litre
 - (g) two litres
 - (h) four litres
 - (i) ten litres
 - (j) twenty litres
4. Farm Products Marketing Commission Order No. 88-1 is hereby repealed.
5. This Order comes into effect on October 30, 1991.
