

# Travelling to the United States by air?

As of January 23, 2007, anyone entering the United States by air will need a valid passport.

If you are flying to the United States, you can prepare for the new U.S. law under the Western Hemisphere Travel Initiative (WHTI) by

- Applying for a passport;
- Keeping your passport up to date; and
- Carrying your passport with you when you travel.



Travel often to the United States by air? Canadians can travel with a NEXUS Air card instead of a passport at designated airports. The NEXUS program offers a simplified and expedited border crossing process to frequent travellers and will be expanding to most major airports across Canada.
