UNLOCATABLE COPYRIGHT OWNER

Non-exclusive licence issued to Richard Lindseth Architecture, Calgary, Alberta, authorizing the reproduction of architectural plans

Pursuant to the provisions of subsection 77(1) of the *Copyright Act*, the Copyright Board grants a licence to Richard Lindseth Architecture, as follows:

(1) The licence authorizes the reproduction of one copy – for renovation purposes only – of the architectural plans designed by J. Sertic Homes (J. Mossman, engineer and J. Pasalic, draftsperson) for the property located at 41 Woodhaven View S.W. in the City of Calgary, Province of Alberta.

This licence does not release the licensee from the obligation to obtain permission for any other use not covered in this licence.

(2) The licence expires on December 31, 2005. The authorized reproduction must therefore be completed by that date.

(3) The licence is non-exclusive and valid only in Canada. For other countries, it is the law of that country that applies.

(4) The licencee will pay the sum of \$25 to any person who establishes, before December 31, 2010, ownership of the copyright in the work covered in this licence.

(5) The coming into force of this licence is conditional on the licencee filing with the Board its undertaking to comply with the conditions set out in paragraph (4) above.
