

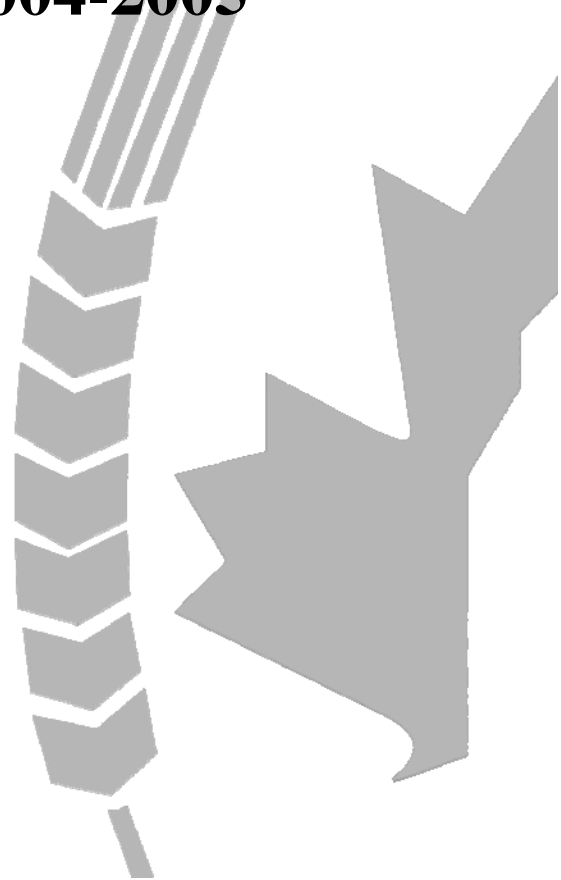

## FOREWORD

The tables which follow in this booklet show the total deliveries of – wheat, oats, barley, flaxseed, canola and peas at licensed primary elevators located at prairie shipping points, for the crop year 2004– 2005, firstly by province and secondly by train runs within grain loading blocks. Also shown are average annual deliveries at each point over the 10-year period 1994-95 to 2003-04.

The total primary elevator capacity (expressed in wheat equivalent tonnes), the number of companies, and the number of elevator licences at each individual point as of August 1, 2005 are shown in the initial columns.

In certain instances the reader will note that the elevator capacity figure is not quoted; this would indicate that the licence had not been renewed for the 2005-06 season. In other instances there is no figure shown against the 2004-2005 deliveries but the 10-year average handling is shown. This indicates that the elevator did not receive any grain during the past crop year.

Primary elevator points falling into train run '00' are, in most cases, no longer licenced facilities; hence, no train run is assigned to them. Those points which are not 'on track' are also included in the '00' train run.

The 10-year average figure in all instances reflects the average deliveries of each delivery point for the number of years in which each received grain within the preceding ten crop years. In calculating the shipping block and provincial 10-year averages, the sum of delivery point totals is used.

Effective in the 1984-85 crop years, the Canadian Grain Commission allowed operators of primary elevators to licence, as a single primary elevator, two or more adjacent facilities which were under the control of a single manager. This is evident in the reduced 'number of elevators' at individual delivery points.

## AVANT-PROPOS

Les tableaux que renferme ce livret indiquent, d'abord par province, ensuite par parcours ferroviaires à l'intérieur des zones d'expédition, le total des arrivages, soit le blé, l'avoine, l'orge, le lin, le canola et le pois pour la campagne agricole 2004-2005, aux silos primaires agréés qui sont situés aux points de collecte des Prairies. Ces tableaux comportent également la moyenne des livraisons annuelles à chaque point de collecte pendant la décennie de 1994-1995 à 2003-2004.

La capacité totale du silo primaire (exprimée en équivalence de tonnes métriques de blé), le nombre de compagnies et le nombre de licences de silos à chaque point de collecte, au 1<sup>er</sup> août 2005, sont indiqués dans les premières colonnes.

Dans certains cas, le lecteur constatera que la capacité du silo n'est pas signalée; c'est le cas du silo dont la licence n'a pas été renouvelée pour la saison 2005-06. Dans d'autres cas, aucun montant n'est indiqué à l'égard des livraisons de 2004 – 2005, seule la moyenne de dix ans est indiquée. C'est l'exemple d'un silo où aucune livraison n'a été faite durant la dernière campagne agricole.

Les silos primaires situés le long d'un parcours ferroviaire '00' ne sont plus, dans la plupart des cas, des installations agréées; donc, aucun train ne leur est assigné. Les silos qui ne sont pas situés le long des voies sont également inclus dans les parcours '00'.

Dans tous les cas, la moyenne de six ans traduit la moyenne des livraisons à chaque point de collecte pour le nombre d'années au cours desquelles chacun des silos a reçu du grain durant les dix campagnes agricoles précédentes. En calculant les moyennes sur dix ans par zone d'expédition et par province, on utilise le total des points de collecte.

Depuis le début de la campagne agricole 1984-1985, la Commission canadienne des grains accepte de délivrer une seule licence aux exploitants de deux silos ou plus lorsque ces silos sont exploités par une seule personne et qu'ils sont attenants. La réduction du nombre de silos aux points de livraison en est la preuve.
