Rules and Regulations

Photo Subject Categories are:

- People at the Canada Agriculture Museum
- 2 Farm Animals
- 3 Special Events at the Canada Agriculture Museum
- 4 Photographs taken at the Museum by children 12 years and under
- All photos must be taken on the Canada Agriculture Museum site and taken from areas accessible to the public. It is prohibited to enter animal pens or go behind exhibition barriers. Photos must be taken between June 17, 2007 and the contest submission deadline of October 31, 2007.
- Only high quality photograph prints, digital photos on CD or digital photos sent by email in JPEG format will be accepted. Digital photos may not be altered using computer software. Any photos that are judged to be altered will be disqualified. Digital cropping and resizing is allowed. Colour, black and white as well as sepia-tone photographs are accepted but must be originally taken in that format.
- The maximum number of photographs per entrant is 3 with no more than 1 per category.
- All entries must be taken by a Canada Science and Technology Museum Corporation (CMSTC) Member.
- All entries must be taken by an amateur photographer. An amateur is deemed to be a person who does
 not make a living selling or taking photographs and whose photographs are not published
 professionally on a regular basis.
- Employees of the CMSTC and their immediate families are not eligible to enter the contest.
- If submitted by email, the total file size must not exceed 2.5 mb to ensure reception of the email. The email must include the photographer's name, phone number, membership number and age (if 12 years or under) and the entry category. If submitted by CD, digital photos must be submitted on a CD in a jewel case, the CD face clearly marked with photographer's name, phone number, membership number and age (if 12 years or under) and the entry category. Prints must be clearly marked on the back of the photograph with photographer's name, phone number, membership number and age (if 12 years or under) and the entry category.
- Participants must retain their original digital files as they will be requested to submit a high resolution copy if they are considered as winners for development and publication purposes. The high resolution file cannot be sent during the contest period if it is sent by email with a total file size exceeding 2.5 mb. Original files totalling more than 2.5 mb must be submitted by CD. A winning photo for which the original high resolution file cannot be received will be disqualified.
- All photographs submitted become the property of the CMSTC and will not be returned.
 The photographer grants the right to the Museum to publish the photograph without further approval, compensation or credit, and to use the image in any promotional material.
- Photos which include a person must be accompanied by a waiver from the person in the photograph (or a guardian), stating that the CMSTC has permission to use the image. Waiver forms will be provided by the Museum.

- The CMSTC will not be responsible for damage or loss of entries incurred while in transit or in our
 possession, although every reasonable care will be taken with each entry. The CSTMC will not be
 responsible for emails sent by participants but not received by the Museum.
