Strengthening the Government of Canada's National Security Agenda

– ISS must make meaningful contributions to the National Security Agenda by ensuring the safeguarding of sensitive government assets and controlled goods and by enabling industry to rapidly serve the needs of the Government, its citizens and our allies in a safe and secure manner. We must help protect the Government and Canadians against potential malicious acts of espionage, theft and terrorist activities.
