

Revised Notice of Public Hearing

A Notice of Public Hearing was published on August 20, 2007 to announce that the Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) is holding a two-day public hearing on an application by Ontario Power Generation (OPG) to renew its licence to operate the Darlington Nuclear Generating Station. This revised Notice of Public Hearing provides information on the new location of the Hearing Day Two.

Hearing Day One was held on November 1, 2007, in Ottawa, Ontario.

Public hearings follow the agenda published prior to the hearing date.

The public is invited to comment on OPG's application either by oral presentation or written submission on Hearing Day Two. Requests to intervene must be filed with the Secretary of the Commission by December 10, 2007 at the address below. The request must include the following information, as per the *CNSC Rules of Procedure*:

- a written submission of the comments to be presented to the Commission;
- a statement setting out whether the requester wishes to intervene by way of written submission only or by way of written submission and oral presentation; and
- name, address and telephone of the requester.
