The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) will hold a two-day public hearing on the application by Ontario Power Generation (OPG) for the renewal of the operating licence for the Pickering Waste Management Facility (PWMF) located in Pickering, Ontario. OPG is requesting that the operating licence be renewed for a ten-year period. OPG is also seeking approval to carry out additional activities during this proposed licence period that include the operation of new storage buildings and on-site transfer of dry storage containers to these buildings.

The PWMF consists of a used fuel dry storage facility for interim storage of used fuel from the Pickering Nuclear Generating Stations A and B and of a retube components storage facility for interim storage of existing irradiated reactor components from the Pickering Nuclear Generating Station A.

The public is invited to comment on OPG's application on Hearing Day Two, either by written submission only or by written submission and oral presentation. Requests to intervene must be filed with the Secretary of the Commission by January 21, 2008 at the address below. The request must include the following information, as per the *CNSC Rules of Procedure*:

- a written submission of the comments to be presented to the Commission;
- a statement setting out whether the requester wishes to intervene by way of written submission only or by way of written submission and oral presentation; and
- name, address and telephone of the requester.
