



Notice of Public Hearing

The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) will hold a one-day public hearing on the application by Ontario Power Generation (OPG) for licence amendments to revise the conditions regarding financial guarantees and decommissioning for all of its nuclear power reactor and waste management facility operating licences.

One-Day Hearing: November 1, 2007

Public hearings follow the agenda published prior to the hearing date.

Submissions from CNSC staff and OPG for the Commission's hearing on the licence amendments will be available after August 31, 2007.

The public is invited to comment on the proposed licence amendments by providing a written submission; there is no opportunity to make an oral presentation at the hearing. The public is invited to observe the proceeding. Requests to intervene must be filed with the Secretary of the Commission by October 2, 2007 at the address below. The request must include the following information, as per the *CNSC Rules of Procedure*:

- a written submission of the comments to be presented to the Commission; and
- name, address and telephone of the requester.
