
A decision was rendered this afternoon by Mr. Justice Michel M.J. Shore of the Federal Court in file IMM—1923-07 (Citation: 2007 CF 1194):

IN THE MATTER OF Rachid DERBAS

SUMMARY: To beat one's wife is no different than to beat a third party, despite the contention of the applicant. For the purpose of interpreting the *Immigration and Refugee Protection Act*, S.C. 2001, c. 27 once section 36 of this legislation is applied, the finding of serious criminality, in itself, bears its own consequences.
