Statement of nomination:

The statement should contain descriptions of volunteer or paid work and the names of organizations. Describe the level of the candidate's responsibilities within these organizations and/or the community.

Describe the innovative achievement(s), lobbying or advocacy efforts the candidate has undertaken with respect to improving equality for women and girls in Canadian society. Provide detailed specific examples of the results of the candidate contributions, including solutions to specific problems, outstanding achievements or laws that were changed as a result of the candidate's work.

Candidate's resume or curriculum vitae:

Provide a separate outline of the candidate's background, career, and current work. Include volunteer work, education, awards or other notable achievements.

Letters of support:

Provide a minimum of two (2), and a maximum of four (4), single-page letters written in direct support of the nomination.
