Preface

This report provides highlights of Canadian agri-food trade in the first three months of 2000. Emphasis is placed on changes in major trade flows compared to the same period in 1999. These changes include four areas: exports and imports; trade balance; the performance of bulk, intermediate and consumer-oriented products; and major destinations for Canadian products and sources of foreign supply.

Please note that the data in this report is subject to revision, and therefore the interpretation of the information should be treated with caution. Highlights for January to March 2000

Trade of Selected Key Commodities

Statistics Canada's agri-food trade data indicate increased exports and imports, as measured by the values of shipments, during January to March 2000 compared to the same period in 1999. A major feature of the current highlights is the recovery in the overall value of bulk exports despite lower wheat prices.

According to Statistics Canada, the total value of Canada's agri-food exports reached \$5.3 billion during January to March 2000, reflecting an increase of 4% over the same period in 1999. Exports of grains, red meats and fresh and processed potatoes were up markedly offsetting the declines recorded in exports of oilseeds and oilseed processed products.

The increases in the value for grain exports resulted in an overall rise of 8% to \$1.6 billion for bulk agri-food exports. Exports of intermediate products were down 12% to \$1.3 billion with the declines in exports of commodities such as oilseed products. Consumer-oriented products, which represented approximately half of the total agri-food exports, rose 12% to \$2.5 billion. This increase in exports of consumer-oriented agri-food products reflects the growing importance of value-added products in the composition of Canada's agri-food trade.

At \$1.1 billion, Canadian grain exports were up 31% during the first three months of 2000 compared to the same period in 1999. The increase in the value of total grain exports was primarily due to rises in the volume shipped: wheat, other than durum wheat, was up 104% to 4.3 million tonnes, barley was up 77% to 463 thousand tonnes, and oats was up 39% to 249 thousand tonnes.

The total value of exports of wheat, excluding durum wheat, were up 71% to \$817 million, barley exports and oat exports reached \$90 million (up 76%) and \$34 million (up 28%) respectively. By contrast, exports of durum wheat were down 28% to \$170 million due to the decline in volume which totalled 724 thousand tonnes or down 29% compared to the high level of shipments registered during the first quarter of 1999.

Exports of grain products such as bakery products, malt and pasta products rose 7% to \$385 million. Bakery products (other than mixes and dough) totalled \$172 million (up 22%) reflecting an increase of 22% in terms of volume of exports to 62 thousand tonnes. Exports of pasta products reached

\$39 million (up 2%), while exports of mixes and dough for the preparation of bakery products remained unchanged at \$42 million. Exports of malt declined 6% to \$43 million.

At \$369 million, during the period of January to March 2000, Canada's exports of live animals excluding poultry were relatively unchanged compared to the same period in 1999. The decline of 9% to \$228 million registered in exports of non dairy cattle was partially offset by the increase of 22% to \$90 million in exports of swine as well as the 10% increase to \$23 million in exports of other live animals and dairy cattle. The large increase in terms of the value of Canada's exports of swine reflected essentially the high prices for hogs registered recently in the U.S. market.

With the increase in slaughtering capacity, Canada's exports of red meats were up 28% to \$841 million. The significant rise registered in exports of red meats reflected primarily increased shipments and higher export prices for beef and pork. Exports of fresh and frozen beef totalled \$385 million (up 20%) reflecting a 12% increase in the volume of exports. At \$309 million, exports of fresh and frozen pork rose by 42% as the volume of these exports (105 thousand tonnes) is up 26%. Exports of other animal products reached \$183 million, was up 7% compared to the period of January to March 1999.

During the period of January to March 2000, Canada's exports of oilseeds declined 27% to \$356 million. Exports of canola were down 29% to \$262 million largely due to low international prices for this commodity. Exports of flaxseed declined by 57% to \$20 million, and exports of mustard seeds were down 33% to \$10 million. By contrast, exports of soybean were up 28% to \$57 million due to increased shipments which rose 31% to 160 thousand tonnes.

Exports of alcoholic beverages were up 7% to \$201 million. The decline in exports of distilled beverages down 3% to \$128 million was offset by the increases recorded by exports of beer and stout up 15% to \$61 million and exports of other fermented beverages (excluding grape wine) which rose to \$10 million during January to March 2000 from only \$1.2 million during the same period in 1999.

Canada's exports of processed products made from plantation crops (i.e. coffee, tea, cocoa, and crude natural latex and rubber) were up 1% to \$134 million. By contrast, exports of floriculture and nursery products declined 7% to \$73 million, and exports of seed for sowing were down 10% to \$66 million. Raw tobacco exports were down 33% to \$26 million due to declining shipments and low prices.

The trade highlights for the period January to March 2000 were also marked by the increase of 18% in exports of fresh and processed potatoes which totalled \$234 million. While exports of dried pulses declined 16% to \$168 million, oilseed products were down 34% to \$194 million and animal feeds were down 4% to \$194 million. Exports of supply managed commodities were mixed, with dairy exports declining by 31% to \$59 million, while exports of poultry and egg products rose 5% to \$44 million.

During the period January to March 2000, Canada's imports of agri-food products rose 5% to \$4 billion. Bulk agri-food imports reached \$518 million (up 7%) while imports of intermediate commodities totalled \$731 million (up 11%). Consumer-oriented products which represented 69% of total agri-food imports were up 4% to \$2.8 billion.

At \$654 million, imports of fruits and nuts accounted for 16% of the total agri-food imports to Canada. Other major imported commodities included fresh and processed vegetables (other than potatoes) which reached \$479 million representing 12% of total agri-food imports. The third largest group of imports were plantation crops such as coffee, tea, cocoa, and crude natural latex and rubber which represented 9% of all agri-food imports or \$349 million. Imports of coffee products declined 11% to \$180 million, and imports of cocoa products were down 9% to \$92 million. Imports of tea products rose 3% to \$34 million while imports of crude natural latex and rubber were up 7% to \$44 million.

Imports of red meats were up 16% to \$286 million consisting mainly of imports of fresh and frozen beef which totalled \$179 million (up 18%). Imports of fresh and frozen pork meat were up 14% to \$33 million. Imports of alcoholic beverages such as grape wine, beer and stout were unchanged at \$255 million, while imports of grain products such as bakery products and pasta products rose 4% to \$253 million.

The increases in imports registered for oilseeds and oilseed products were 34% to \$80 million and 26% to \$150 million, respectively. Dairy products, mainly cheeses, were up 21% to \$86 million; imports of dairy products, however, are expected to return normal level. Imports of seeds for sowing up 20% to \$84 million. By contrast, imports of sugar products were up only 1% to \$83 million, and imports of floriculture and nursery products were up 2% to \$98 million.

The value of Canada's total agri-food trade reached \$9.4 billion, up by approximately 5% compared to the first quarter period of 1999. The total value of the agri-food trade surplus was unchanged at \$1.2 billion. However, during January and

March 2000 the trade surplus for agri-food bulk commodities rose 8% to \$1 billion, while the deficit in consumer-oriented agri-food products was down by 33% to \$341 million. These trade improvements in bulk and consumer-oriented products helped offset the decline of 31% of the surplus for intermediate commodities which fell to \$525 million.

Agri-Food Trade with the U.S.

The value of Canada's shipments to the U.S. represented 60% of total agri-food exports during the period of January to March 2000. Agri-food exports to the U.S. totalled \$3.2 billion (up 3%) during the period of January to March 2000. While exports of bulk commodities declined 24% to \$280 million, due to the sharp decline in the exports of grains and oilseeds, exports of intermediate products were down 4% to \$853 million; by contrast, exports of consumer-oriented agri-food products to the U.S. reached \$2.1 billion, up 13% compared to the same period in 1999.

During the first quarter of 2000, Canada's agri-food trade with the U.S. was marked by the increases registered in terms of exports of red meats (up 25% to \$612 million), grain products (up 13% to \$340 million), fresh and processed potatoes (up 30% to \$198 million), alcoholic beverages (up 11% to \$191 million), fruits and nuts (up 29% to \$46 million), poultry and egg products (up 13% to \$24 million) and dried pulses (up 41% to \$12 million).

Conversely, exports of grains, oilseeds and oilseed products to the U.S. were all down from the levels recorded in first quarter 1999. The export value of grains, oilseeds and oilseed products declined 25%, 37% and 21% to \$152 million, \$50 million and \$164 million, respectively.

Imports from the U.S. accounted for 62% of the value of all imported agri-food products entering Canada in the first three month period of 2000. Although imports of bulk and intermediate agri-food commodities rose 33% to \$241 million and 11% to \$543 million, respectively, most agri-food imports from the U.S. were consumer-oriented products which represented 69% of these total imports or \$1.8 billion, up 5% compared to the same period in 1999.

The most important group of imported commodities from the U.S. was fresh and processed vegetables which totalled \$345 million (down 2%), followed by fruit and nut imports which were unchanged at \$303 million. Imports of grain products such as bakery products and pasta products reached \$213 million (up 6%) while imports of fresh and processed red meats rose 18% to \$173 million and animal feeds were up 11% to \$153 million.

Agri-Food Trade with Selected Countries and Regions

The agri-food trade surplus with regard to the U.S. declined by 13% to \$660 million during the period of January to March 2000 compared to \$756 million in the same period in 1999; however, the surplus in terms of consumer-oriented products rose from \$162 million to \$310 million in the first three month period of 2000.

Canada's agri-food exports to the European Union (EU-15) were down 32% to \$197 million. Beside the few exceptions such as fruit and nuts, Canada's major agri-food commodities exported to the EU-15 have declined markedly in January to March 2000 compared to the same period of 1999. Grain exports declined 54% to \$28 million, dried pulse exports were down 29% to \$38 million, and oilseed exports reached \$20 million, down 39%.

Exports of agri-food products to Japan reached \$459 million down by 1%. The trade situation, however, varied significantly between commodities. Canada's exports of oilseeds to Japan were down 11% to \$143 million; by contrast, red meat exports were up 27% to \$123 million. While exports of grains totalled \$89 million (down 7%), exports of grain products reached \$23 million (up 11%).

Canada's agri-food exports to the rest-of-Asia (excluding Japan) were down 8% to \$454 million reflecting especially the declines in exports to China (down 7% to \$170 million), Hong Kong (down 6% to \$51 million), Malaysia (down 49% to \$23 million) and the Philippines (down 17% to \$26 million). Canada's agri-food exports to some Asian destinations were up during the period of January to March 2000 as a result of the recovery in economic activities. For example, the value of shipments to South Korea rose by 24% to \$64 million.


Exports to Mexico were down 7% to \$122 million during the first quarter of 2000 as a result of the declines in grain and oilseed shipments. Canada's grain exports to Mexico declined by 37% to \$22 million, oilseed exports were down 12% to \$56 million. However the value of exports of red meats to Mexico has more than tripled totalling \$23 million. The trade data indicated a surge in exports to Iran from \$17 million during the January and March 1999 to \$304 million in the first three months of 2000.

During the period of January to March 2000, imports of agri-food products entering Canada from the EU-15 declined 2% to \$456 million. At \$145 million, imports of alcoholic beverages were down 11%. Imports of products made from plantation crops such as coffee, tea and cocoa declined 5% to \$40 million, while fruit and nut imports were down 7% to

\$26 million, and dairy imports mainly cheeses were down 4% to \$32 million. However, imports from the EU-15 of animal products other than red meats, dairy, poultry and eggs rose by 38% to \$23 million.

Canada's imports of agri-food products from Asia during January to March 2000 were unchanged at \$229 million. While imports of plantation crops were down by 14% to \$61 million, imports of vegetables other than potatoes rose by 21% to \$22 million. Imports of fruit and nuts were up 1% to \$36 million. Grain imports from Asia, mainly rice, were up 1% to \$17 million. Imports from China rose 12% to \$54 million, while imports from Indonesia and Malaysia declined by 15% each to \$33 million and \$17 million, respectively.

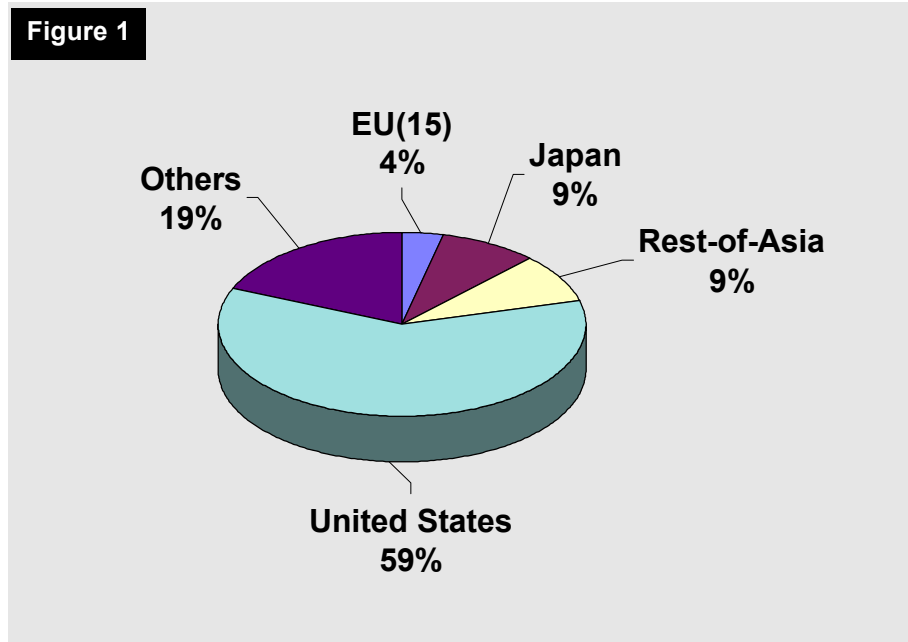
Imports from Mexico totalled \$126 million (up 13%) reflecting increases in imports of vegetables other than potatoes (up 14% to \$67 million), fruit and nut (up 3% to \$25 million), alcoholic beverages (up 63% to \$12 million) and plantation crops (up 19% to \$11 million). Imports from Chile reached \$95 million (up 7%) as a result of the increases in imports of fruit and nut (up 11% to \$79 million) and alcoholic beverages mainly wine (up 4% to \$14 million). During the January to March 2000, imports from Brazil were down 5% to \$91 million reflecting the declines in imports of sugar products (down 60% to \$5 million) and plantation crops (down 8% to \$40 million).



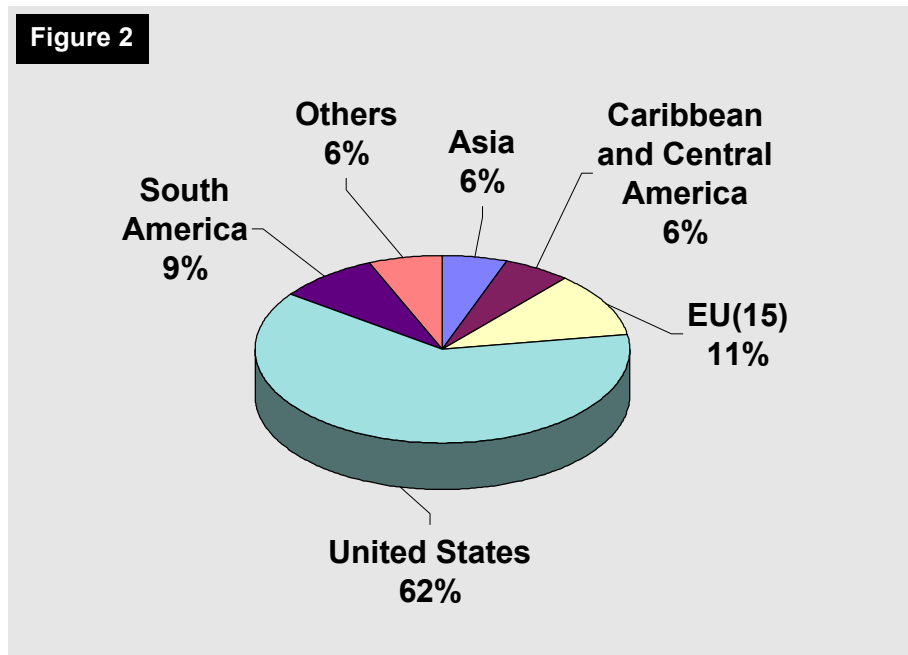

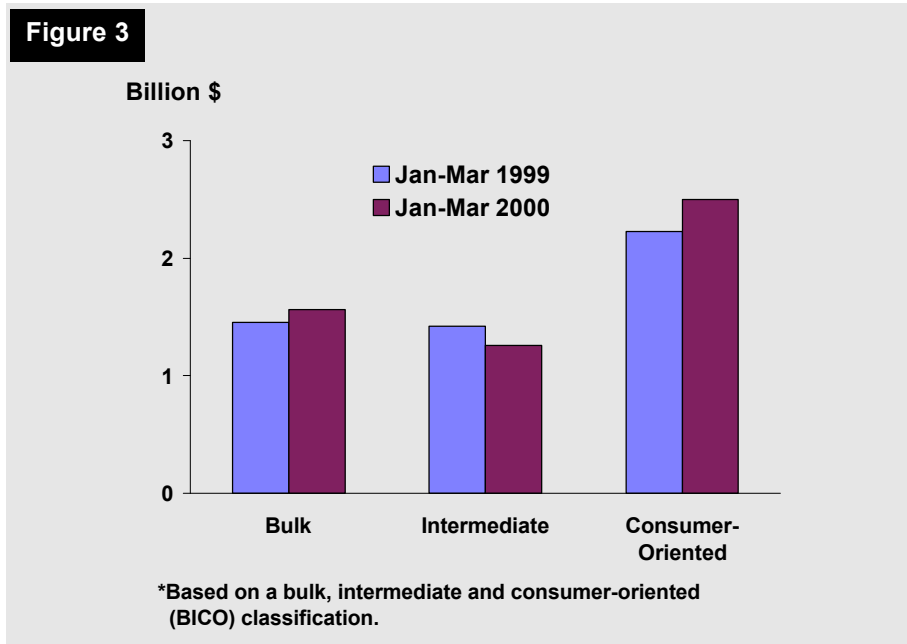
Shares of Total Canadian Agri-Food Exports by Destinations



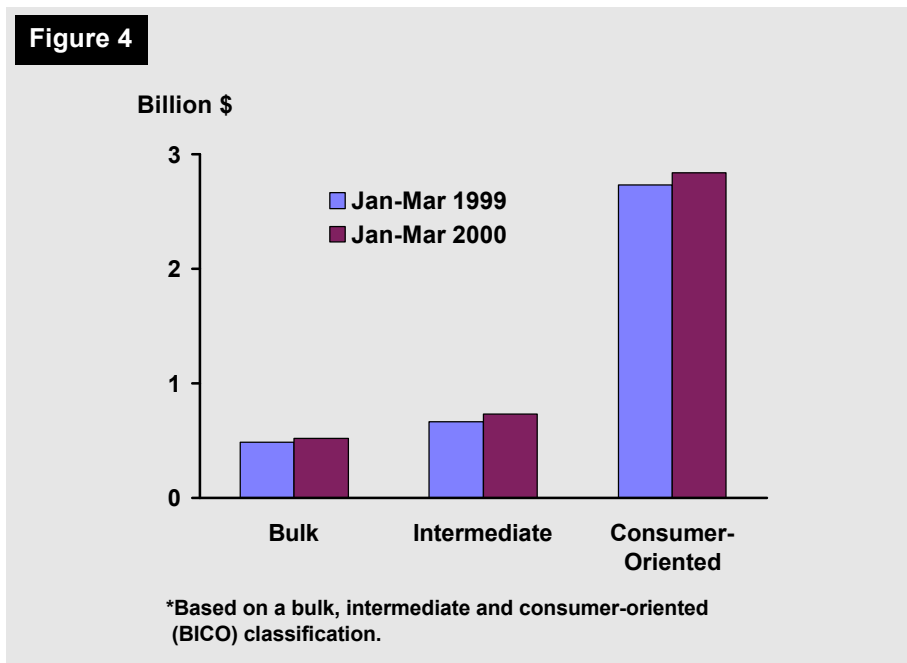
Shares of Total Canadian Agri-Food Imports by Sources



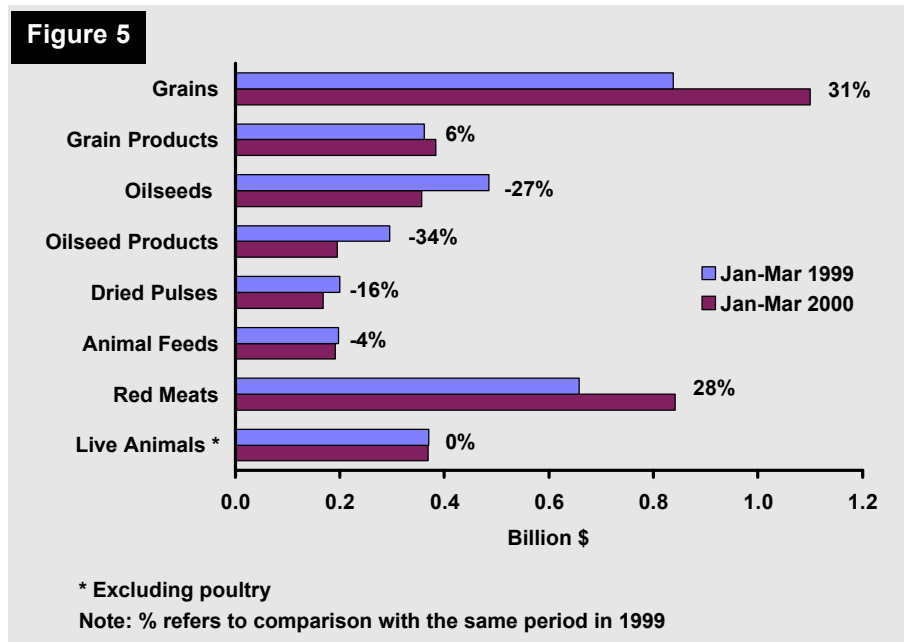
Canadian Exports of Agri-Food Products*



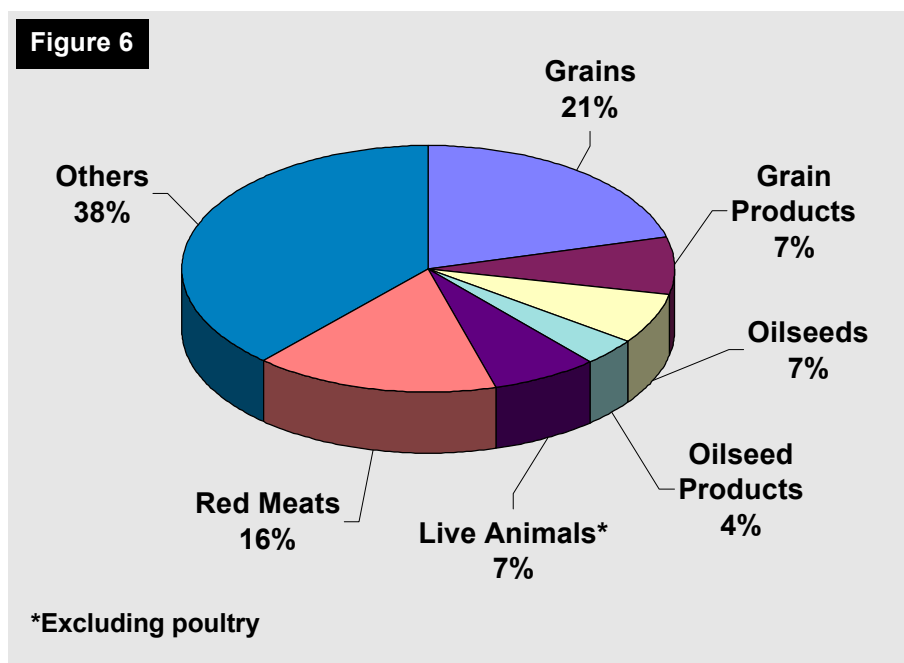
Canadian Imports of Agri-Food Products*



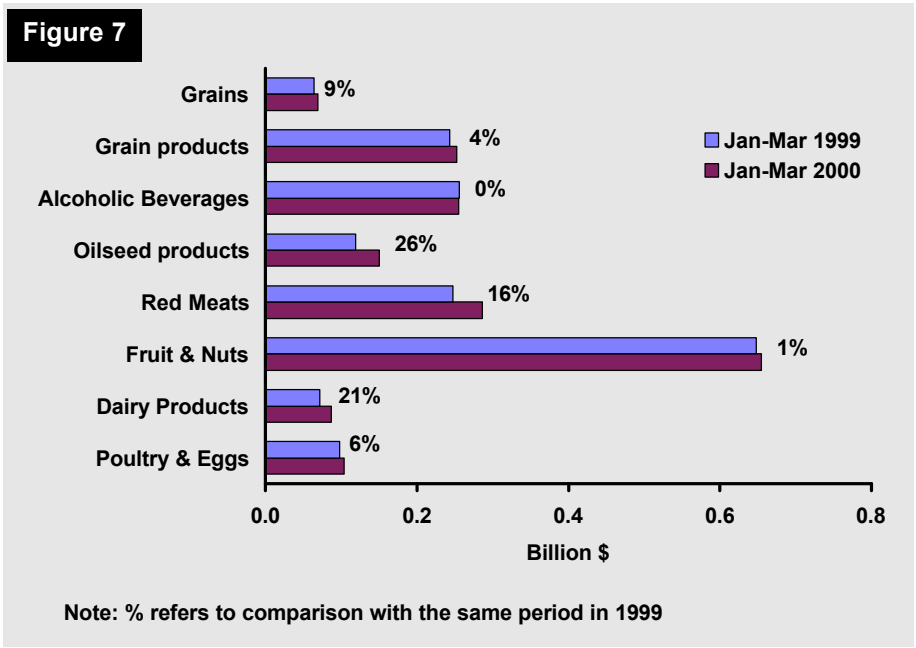
Canadian Exports of Selected Agri-Food Commodity Groups



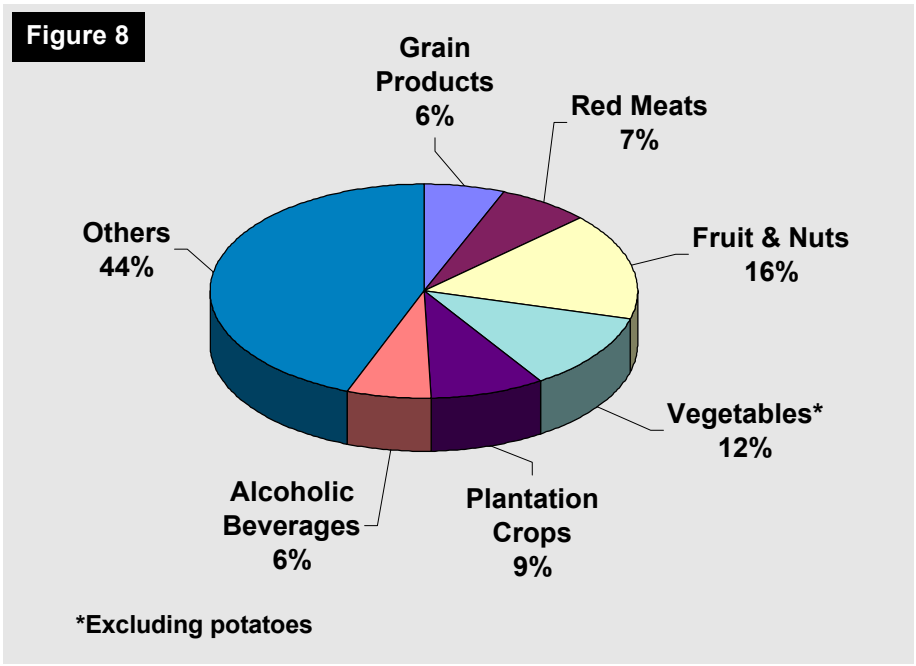
Shares of Total Canadian Agri-Food Exports by Commodity Groups



Canadian Imports of Selected Agri-Food Commodity Groups

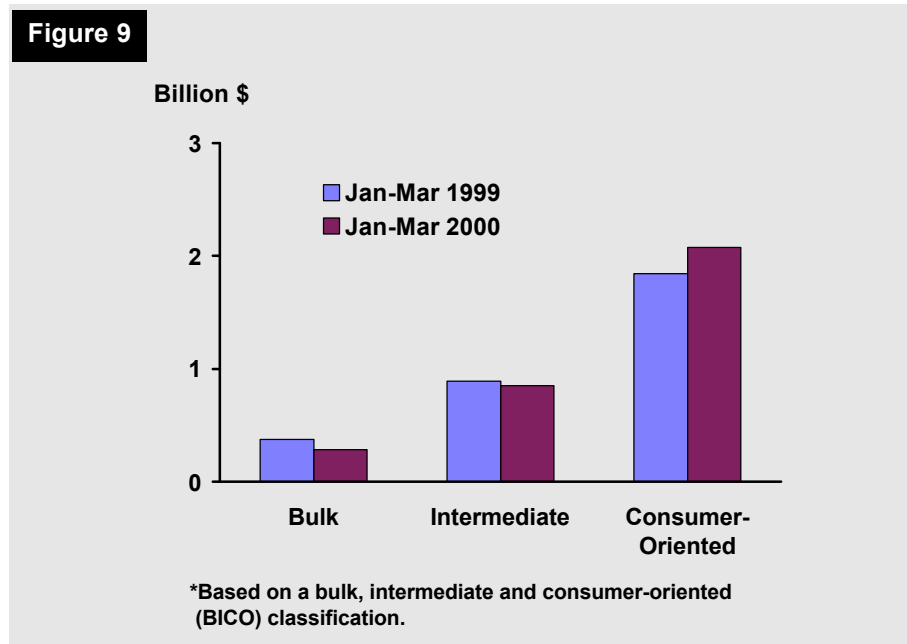


Shares of Total Canadian Agri-Food Imports by Commodity Groups

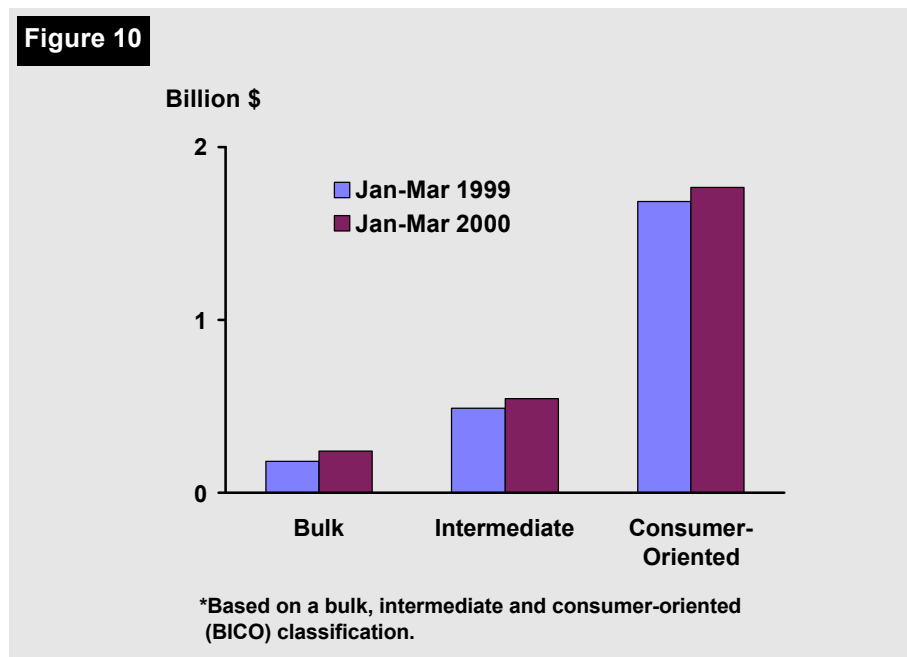

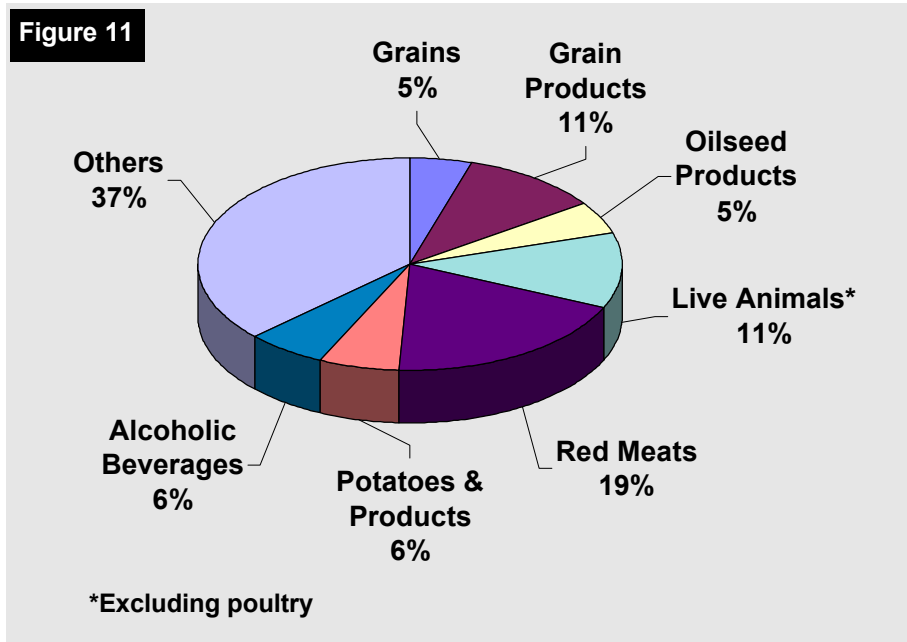
Canadian Exports of Agri-Food Products to the U.S.*



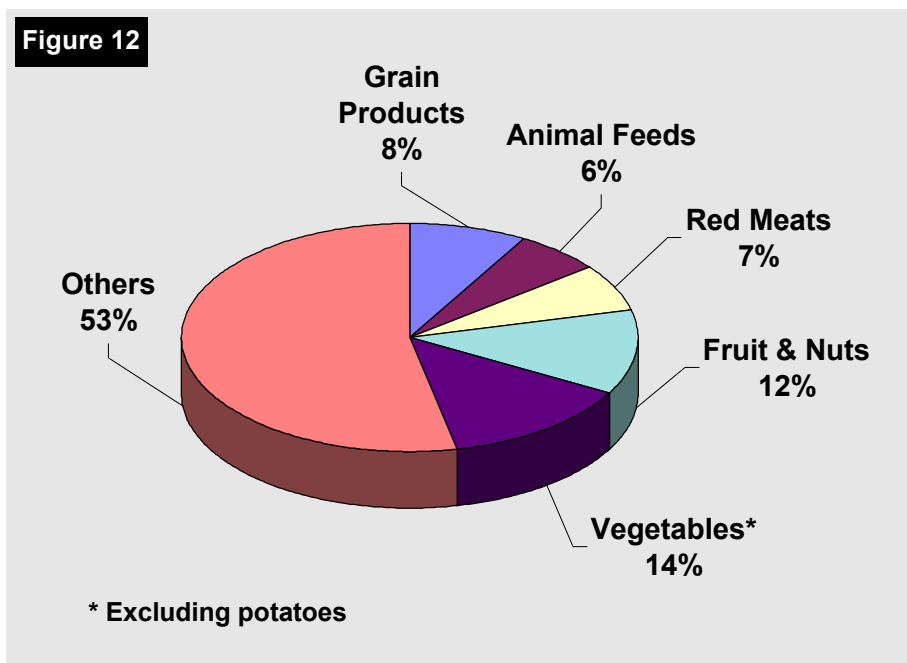
Canadian Imports of Agri-Food Products to the U.S.*



Shares of Canadian Agri-Food Exports to the U.S. by Selected Commodity Groups

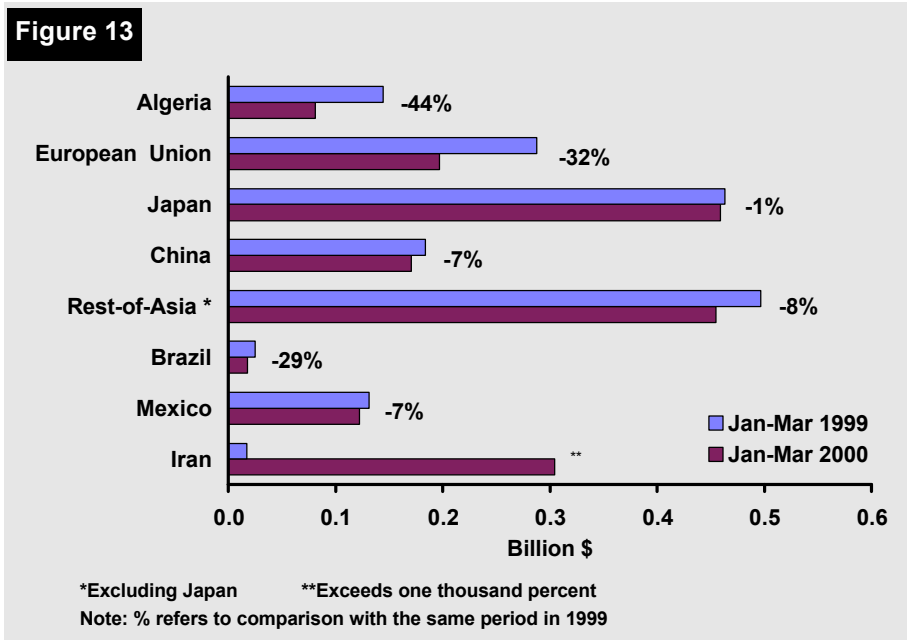


Shares of Canadian Agri-Food Imports from the U.S. by Selected Commodity Groups

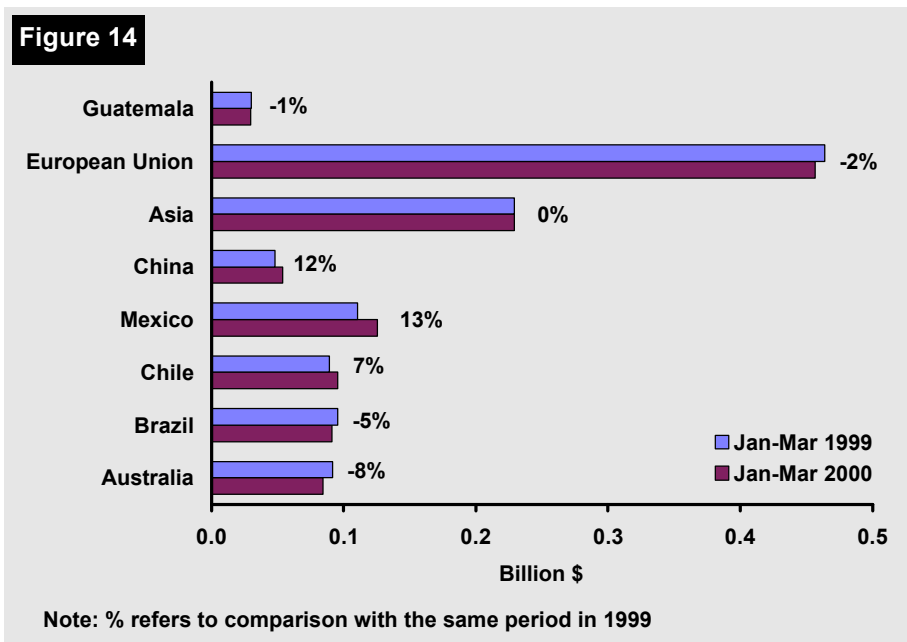



Trade with Major Regions and Countries Other than the United States
