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INTRODUCTION

The *National Inventory of Treatment Programs for Child Sexual Abuse Offenders* was first published in 1989. The listing has proven to be a valuable resource for individuals, agencies and institutions across Canada and has been updated twice since it was first compiled (1993, 1996). The National Clearinghouse on Family Violence has made some changes to the 1999 Inventory. Information on each program has been updated and, in many cases, now includes an e-mail address. Names of contact persons have been eliminated since these tend to become out of date more quickly. The 1999 Inventory is smaller than its predecessors as it no longer provides program descriptions; however, programs may be contacted directly for further information.

In the 1999 Inventory, programs are listed by province from east to west, and within each province or territory alphabetically by city or town.

INTRODUCTION

La publication initiale du *Répertoire national des programmes de traitement pour auteurs d'agressions sexuelles sur les enfants* remonte à 1989. Ce document s'est avéré extrêmement utile comme ressource pour les personnes, agences et institutions partout au Canada, et il a connu deux mises à jour depuis sa compilation (1993, 1996). Le Centre national d'information sur la violence dans la famille a apporté des changements à l'édition de 1999. Les données relatives à chaque programme ont été actualisées et, dans bien des cas, elles contiennent à présent une adresse électronique. Cependant, les noms des personnes ressources (contacts) ont été supprimés étant donné qu'ils deviennent périmés beaucoup plus rapidement. Le répertoire de 1999 est plus compact que les éditions précédentes et il ne contient plus de descriptions de programmes.
