**Profile of Funding to Saskatchewan, 1998-99 /
Profil de l'aide accordée à la Saskatchewan, 1998-99**

FUNDING TO SASKATCHEWAN, 1998-99

- In 1998-99, the Canada Council for the Arts provided grants worth almost \$2.4 million to the arts in Saskatchewan.
- In addition, \$162,000 in payments was provided to 252 Saskatchewan authors through the Public Lending Right Program¹. This brings the total amount of Canada Council funding to Saskatchewan to almost \$2.6 million.
- The Council awarded \$374,000 in grants to 39 Saskatchewan artists and \$2 million to 64 Saskatchewan organizations.
- Grants were provided in every artistic discipline - dance, music, theatre, visual arts, media arts, writing and publishing and interdisciplinary art. The largest amount of funding (\$723,000) went to visual arts, followed by theatre (\$536,000) and writing and publishing (\$419,000).
- Almost \$1.2 million in Council funding went to artists and arts organizations in Regina, making up (51%) of the funding going to the province. Saskatoon received \$957,885 (about 40% of the total). In total, all other communities in Saskatchewan received \$210,178 (almost 9% of the total).
- 13 Saskatchewan artists and arts professionals served as peer assessors in 1997-98, making up 2.2% of all peer assessors.
- Saskatchewan artists and arts organizations received 2.3% of Canada Council funding. In comparison, the province makes up approximately 2.3% of cultural workers and 3.4% of the population of Canada.
- According to the 1996 Census, there over 11,000 culture workers in Saskatchewan, including over 3,100 artists.

AIDE ACCORDÉE À LA SASKATCHEWAN, 1998-1999

- En 1998-1999, le Conseil des Arts du Canada a accordé des subventions d'une valeur totale de près de 2,4 millions de dollars aux arts de la Saskatchewan.
- Par ailleurs, il a fait des paiements d'une valeur totale de plus de 162 000 \$ à 252 auteurs de la Saskatchewan dans le cadre du Programme du droit de prêt public.¹ Ces paiements portent à près de 2,6 millions de dollars le montant total des fonds que la Saskatchewan a reçus du Conseil des Arts du Canada.
- Le Conseil a accordé des subventions d'une valeur totale de 374 000 \$ à 39 artistes de la Saskatchewan et de 2 millions de dollars à 64 organismes artistiques de la Saskatchewan.
- Le Conseil a attribué des subventions dans toutes les disciplines artistiques - danse, musique, théâtre, arts visuels, arts médiatiques, lettres et édition et art interdisciplinaire. Le montant le plus élevé (723 000 \$) a été attribué aux arts visuels, suivis par le théâtre (536 000 \$) et par les lettres et l'édition (419 000 \$).
- Le Conseil a accordé près de 1,2 million aux artistes et organismes artistiques de Regina, soit 51 p. 100 des fonds accordés à la province. La ville de Saskatoon a reçu 957 885 \$ (environ 40 p. 100 du total). En tout, toutes les autres collectivités de la Saskatchewan ont reçu 210 178 \$ (près de 9 p. 100 du total).
- 13 artistes et professionnels des arts de la Saskatchewan ont rempli des fonctions d'évaluateurs en 1997-1998, soit 2,2 p. 100 de tous les évaluateurs du Conseil.
- Les artistes et organismes artistiques de la Saskatchewan ont reçu 2,3 p. 100 de l'aide du Conseil des Arts du Canada. La province représente approximativement 2,3 p. 100 des travailleurs du secteur culturel et 3,4 p. 100 de la population du Canada.
- Selon le recensement de 1996, la Saskatchewan compte 11 000 travailleurs du secteur culturel, dont 3 100 artistes.
