- to demonstrate how to achieve better policy and program outcomes that support gender equality.

- Assist in the design of customized training programs and refer departments and other partners to qualified trainers.
- Help to develop and sustain knowledge of the mechanisms, concepts and tools of GBA as well as to improve its quality through information dissemination and educational activities.

- Provide GBA-related technical assistance, through partnerships and pilot projects, to federal departments and other interested parties in order to implement change that will enable the achievement of gender equality.
