- The applicant must sign the application form. The applicant must be a resident of Canada or a representative of a company with an office in Canada AND must be knowledgeable of the contents of the shipment.
- There is a six (6) to eight (8) week processing period for all applications.
- If the application is approved, the permit and instructions will be sent by mail to the applicant.
- If you would like your permit sent by courier, provide us with a pre-paid envelope and your business account number or VISA or MasterCard number to pay courier charges. Permit will be sent to the address provided in Section 3A, unless otherwise specified by the applicant.
- Import and export of plants and their parts and derivatives is also controlled by the **Plant Protection Act** implemented by the **Canadian Food Inspection Agency (CFIA)**.
