Notwithstanding the foregoing, the Office reserves the right to reject any and all proposals, including valid proposals, without stating the reasons. In addition, the Office reserves the right to exclude from any resulting contract any of the identified activities or deliverables. Please note that the Office will take the overall cost of the review into consideration.

The completed form must be submitted with a resume/CV that includes the following information:

- Education (professional qualifications, academic degrees, discipline, institutional name, city and province, year completed).
 - Employment history (employer name, city, province, position, dates held, major job responsibilities and/or accomplishments).
 - Social Security actuarial-related professional participation (presentations, publications, committee service, etc.).
 - Relevant pension, investment and risk management experience.
 - Estimate of the hourly rate that will be charged as well as the anticipated number of hours based on the current Terms of Reference and previous Actuarial Reviews of the 17th, 18th and 21st CPP Actuarial Reports.
