FUNDING IN ALBERTA, 1998-99

- In 1998-99, the Canada Council for the Arts provided grants worth \$6.9 million to the arts in Alberta
- In addition to grants, almost \$364,000 in payments was provided to 596 authors through the Public Lending Right Program¹.
- This brings the total amount of Canada Council funding to Alberta to over \$7.3 million.
- The Council awarded \$5.8 million to 87 arts organizations and over \$1.1 million went to 80 artists
- Grants were awarded in every discipline - dance, music, theatre, visual arts, media (film, video and new media and writing and publishing. The largest amounts of funding went to music (\$2.2 million), followed by theatre (\$1.5 million) and visual arts (\$1.2 million).
- Almost \$3 million in Council funding went to artists and arts organizations in Edmonton, making up 43.4% of funding going to the province. Calgary received \$2.9 million (41.3% of the total). The remaining communities received over \$1.1 million (15.4% of the total).
- 38 Alberta artists and arts professionals served as peer assessors in 1997-98, making up 6.3% of all peer assessors.
- Alberta artists and arts organizations received 6.7% of Canada Council funding. In comparison, the province makes up 8.4% of culture workers and 9.3% of the Canadian population.
- According to the 1996 Census, there were almost 40,000 culture workers in Alberta, including 10,700 artists.

AIDE ACCORDÉE EN ALBERTA, 1998-99

- En 1998-99, le Conseil des Arts du Canada a accordé 6,9 millions de dollars en subventions aux arts en Alberta.
- En outre, près de 364 000 \$ ont été payés à 596 écrivains de l'Alberta dans le cadre du Programme du droit de prêt public².
- Ce qui porte le montant total des subventions du Conseil des Arts en Alberta à plus de 7,3 millions de dollars.
- Le Conseil a distribué 5,8 millions de dollars à 87 organismes artistiques et plus de 1,1 million à 80 artistes.
- L'aide du Conseil a touché toutes les disciplines : danse, musique, théâtre, arts visuels, arts médiatiques (film, vidéo et nouveaux médias) et lettres et édition. Le plus gros pourcentage de l'aide est allé à la musique (2,2 millions de dollars) puis au théâtre (1,5 million de dollars) et aux arts visuels (1,2 million de dollars).
- Près de 3 millions de dollars ont été distribués aux artistes et aux organismes artistiques d'Edmonton, ce qui représente 43,4 p. cent de l'aide totale accordée à la province. Calgary a reçu 2,9 millions de dollars (41,3 p. cent du total). Les autres collectivités de l'Alberta ont touché 1,1 million de dollars (15,4 p. cent du total).
- En 1997-98, trente-huit artistes et professionnels des arts de l'Alberta ont œuvré comme évaluateurs de leurs pairs, ce qui représente 6,3 p. cent de tous les évaluateurs de pairs auxquels le Conseil a fait appel.
- Les artistes et organismes artistiques de l'Alberta ont reçu 6,7 p. cent de l'aide globale du Conseil des Arts au Canada. Pour fins de comparaison, la province compte 8,4 p. cent de tous les emplois liés au domaine de la culture et 9,3 p. cent de toute la population canadienne.
- Selon le Recensement de 1996, en Alberta, il y aurait 40 000 emplois liés au domaine de la culture dont 10 700 artistes.
