- Configure and train the autoclassification tool








- Teach by examples

- Download file plan into HRDC Automated System (ForeMost (4M))
- Download data to system (as per FSG utility)
- Demo to client (LMI JWTC)

- Training users
- Determining use of shared drives vs. 4M
- **Developing procedures**
- **Expansion of Autoclassification Services**
 - Common drives (project vs. personal)
 - Full / partial autoclassification







Time and Cost

\$10,000 (one-time cost for proof of concept)
Time:

File plan – 5 days

Teach Autoclassification tool – 2 days

Run Autoclassification tool – 0.5 day

Develop conversion program – 2 days

Migrate data to 4M – 0.5 day

Estimate for expansion of Autoclassification

\$.35 per document (75K per document)
